### **Our Facilities and Session Times**

The Town of Victoria Park owns and maintains lease agreements with our fellow co-tenants, the Toy Library and the Carlisle/Lathlain Child Health Nurse. We share the communal areas including the kitchen, toilets and outside space.

Session times are flexible but generally morning sessions will take place between 8-12pm and afternoon sessions to commence from 12pm. Day leaders should liaise with the Membership Coordinator if they change the usual time they open or leave for insurance purposes.

### **Membership fees**

### How does it work?

Full Family Membership is \$185 per annum. There are discounts for concession card holders and for paying fees early, refer below. Annual membership is from 1 February to 31 January. Members joining part way through the year pay a pro rata amount, at the discretion of the Treasurer.

### The details

The total membership fee to attend our playgroup is made up of two parts:

The Playgroup WA (PGWA) insurance fee: This includes your membership with PGWA and insurance for your family/carer group. This fee is transferable between playgroups in WA and is set by PGWA at \$35. If you have any valid concession cards (need documentation proof), your Playgroup WA fee is reduced to \$15.

The PGWA fee covers all children in that family/carer group. In order to provide this insurance coverage, details of each child attending playgroup (name, age, birth date and gender) must be provided to playgroup which are then updated in PGWA's database. For this reason it is important that details of any new children in your family/carer group are provided to the playgroup.


The Lathlain Playgroup membership fee: This fee is paid per family/carer and allows our playgroup to cover the costs of running the building and providing playgroup services and equipment. The annual membership fee is \$150 in addition to the \$35 insurance fee.

# **Summary**

Full Family Membership = \$185 per annum, or \$165 if paid by 1 March Playgroup Plus Membership = \$90 per annum or \$80 if paid by 1 March Paid Elsewhere = \$150 per annum, or \$130 if paid by 1 March.

### What if I leave part way through the year?

You are entitled to a refund on part of your membership fee on a pro-rata by term basis (with a minimum total fee of one term). Please note that the PGWA insurance portion of your fee is non-refundable. To terminate your place in your

### **Frequently Asked Questions**

### Can I bring friends and relatives to playgroup?

It's best to check with your day leader as a courtesy. You may bring visitors from time to time, or share 'parent duties' with another person such as a grandparent. Visitors are asked to sign in at the bottom of the sign in sheet for that session.

### Can I bring my own food?

Yes definitely, please do! Due to members with severe allergies, we ask that no nuts or nut products are brought into playgroup. We also do not permit whole egg or products containing a significant amount of eggs in any session.

Cakes, biscuits with egg is permitted but we ask that all food carefully cleaned away at the end of each session. Sessions that have children attending with severe allergies may adopt further restrictions.

Please note we may revise this list in accordance with members' needs. **Please let us know if your child has any life threatening allergies.** 

# Can I hire playgroup for birthday parties?
